Re: New York State – 100% Workforce Pause Restriction **Exemption**

To Whom It May Concern:

Priority Home Care, Inc. (“Priority”) provides home health care services to the elderly, ill, disabled and other vulnerable individuals. As such, Priority is defined as an “essential business” by New York State and is exempt from travel and work restrictions. Additionally, Priority is an 1199 SEIU union health care Company with over 2,000 essential health care employees in the New York metropolitan region.

The employee presenting this letter is an administrative employee of Priority and is responsible for payroll and accounting functions, which are also deemed as “essential services for health care”, to assure payment of these workers and as such is permitted to travel to perform such duties under the Governor’s Executive Order.
